

Pouncer 12" Block / Toss Pillow

Cut the Following Fabrics

Cut a 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" background fabric (piece A)

Iron a piece of fusible webbing to back of fabric and fussy cut a 'Pouncer Cat'

Alternatively you may cut a 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" background fabric and create your own applique from scrap fabrics. Use scrap fabrics and the 'Pouncer Drawing'.

Another Option is to use a piece of floral for the center and skip the applique

2 - 1" x 5 1/2" - B

2 - 1" x 10 1/2" - C

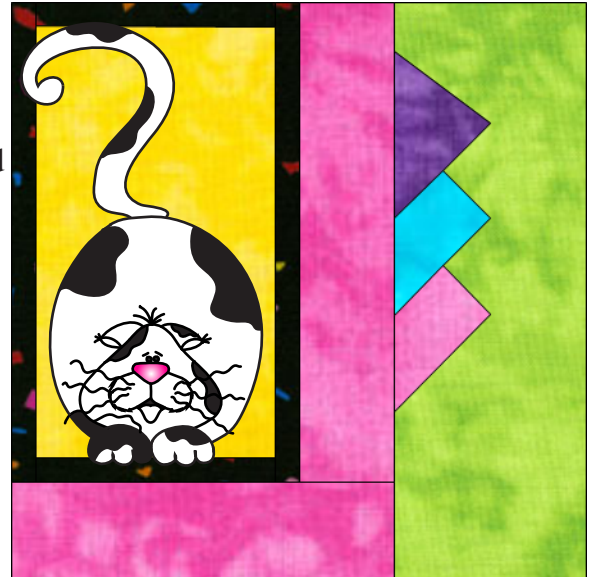
1 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" - D

1 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" - E

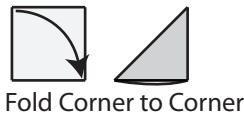
1 - 4 1/2" x 12 1/2"

3 - 4" x 4" prairie points

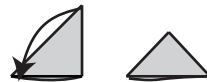
1 - 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" backing piece



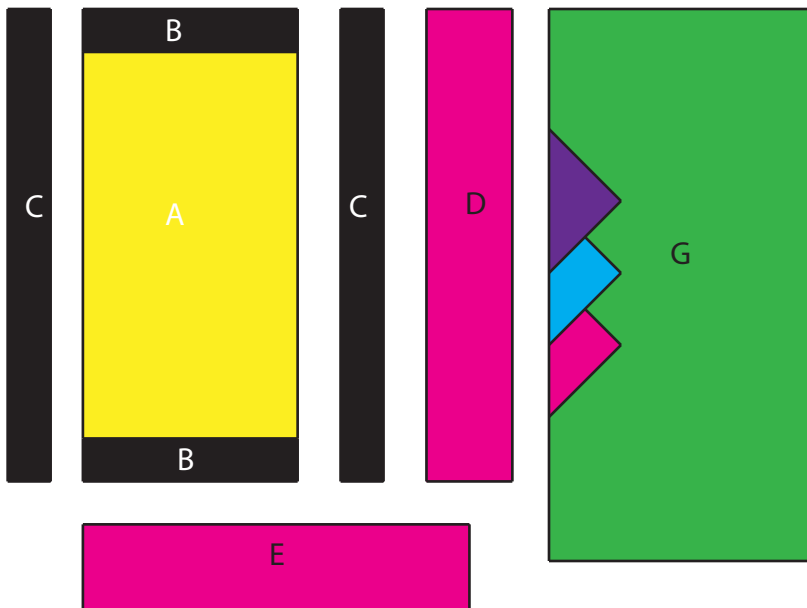
Make 3 prairie points as shown at right.
Assemble block as shown below.



Fold Corner to Corner



Fold Corner to Corner again



Sew onto a 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" backing piece, right sides together. Sew around 4 sides, leaving an opening for turning and stuffing.

Turn right sides out. Stuff with polyfil. Hand sew opening closed.

For larger pillows simply add more outside borders. Increase backing accordingly.
